Class Dojo

We love using Class Dojo as a way of keeping you informed about your child's time at school.



Class Dojo is an app that will:

- Send you short messages and reminders from your child's teacher
- Share with you the house points that your child receives each day
- Share with you photographs of the learning and activities that have been happening in each class
- Allow you to send brief messages to your child's teacher

In order for this to work effectively, we have agreed the following:

- Teachers will check the app for 10 minutes each morning and respond to messages if needed
- The messaging service is for brief messages only, any more detailed communication must continue to come via email or the school office
- 1-2 photographs of children's learning will be shared per week
- Depending on the age of the children and other behaviour systems already in place in different classes, the number of house points awarded may differ between classes. Parents should not compare the number of house points siblings in different classes are awarded as teachers may award them for different things
- Senior staff have access to all classes and can see the communication between parents and staff.
