These will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Myths -Historical fiction -Poetry -Wordless books -Non-fiction <p>When writing we will be inspired by the texts we have read and will write a range of genres including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Reports -Poems -Persuasive letters -Historical narratives -Adventure stories 	<p>In year 3, we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Simplifying fractions -Finding equivalent fractions -Adding and subtractions fractions -Solving word problems -Finding angles -Drawing and describing 2d shapes -Describing 3d shapes -Calculating perimeter <p>In year 4, we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Measuring mass and volume - Converting unit of mass -Measuring volume, height and length -Measuring perimeter -Exploring types of angles -Comparing angles -Classifying triangles and quadrilaterals -Drawing lines of symmetry -Describing positions and plotting points -Writhing Roman numbers to 100. 	<p>Plants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers -Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant -Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants. -Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal. <p>Document editing and word processing</p> <p>We will learn how to use:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Find and replace -Formatting -Text wrapping -Bullet points -Keyboard shortcuts -Copy and paste 	<p>The Roman Empire</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Know when and why the Roman invasion of Britain took place -Know that the Celts, led by a warrior called Boudicca tried to fight back -Know that the Romans changed the lives of people in Britain -Know about the Roman legacy- place names, numerals, calendar, architecture and law <p>Volcanoes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Locate Italy and its key cities and surrounding countries in Europe using maps -Identify key physical and human characteristics of Mount Vesuvius -Understand the different features of a volcano and how they are formed. -Understand the impact of volcanoes on humans and nature -Know about different types of settlements and land use linked to the human and physical features of the areas 	<p>Drawing</p> <p>We will studying the artwork of Giovanni Paolo Panini. We will learn how to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use different techniques to add light and shadow -Use techniques to add effects such as hatching and cross hatching -Use different materials to draw, e.g. pastels and chalk to achieve variations in line, texture, tone, colour and shape -Draw carefully from observation <p>Plan, refine and alter drawings</p> <p>Textiles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Cut and join fabric with some accuracy -Measure, mark and cut out fabric using a paper template -Select a stitch to join fabric, working to sew neat stitches -Attach a fastening for coin purse
