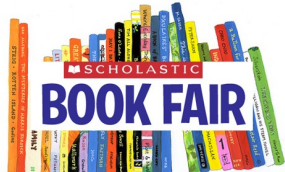

Dance for Chance

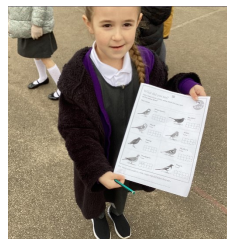
